


Home Project Readiness Evaluation

Are you prepared to tackle a major home improvement or construction project? Answer the following six questions to determine your overall project readiness. The scale runs from "I've still got a lot of work to do (1)" to "All systems go (10)".



Be honest... did you have some low scores on this worksheet? If so, no worries.

Of course there are *always* unknowns in remodeling and construction, particularly at the beginning of a project. If you scored yourself below 8 on any of these measures, though, you should consider it a sign that there is some work left to do. Why? Failure to plan is the number one reason home improvement and construction projects go over budget or blow through deadlines.
